



Wise Up With Water

Water is metered at the University and we are charged for water use and sewerage per metre so our water costs are hit twice!

It is important that we do not take this precious resource for granted and that we use water wisely.

How you can help

- Turn off taps, and cooling systems after use
- Use a sink plug where available
- Avoid leaving taps on when washing hands
- Use the energy saving and half load facility on appliances
- Don't overfill the kettle, only use the amount of water you need
- Report leaking taps to Facilities Helpdesk on 6464

Did you know?

A running tap can use up to nine litres a minute! A tap constantly dripping wastes around 90 litres of water every week, that's 4680 litres a year. This is equivalent to having 46 baths!
