#### **Exhibition Proposals for the Academic Year 2012-2013**

Proposals are invited for exhibitions at the Ruskin Gallery during the academic year 2012-2013.

Proposals are particularly welcome for digital artists interested in using the Digital Gallery exhibition facilities at the Ruskin Gallery. Housed in the Ruskin Gallery, part of the Cambridge School of Art which was opened by John Ruskin in 1858, this innovative new gallery, installed during 2011 at a cost of £450,000, displays art in a digital format on High Definition screens, including the world's first Panasonic 103" 3D Full HD plasma screen, specially imported from Japan.

Exhibitions are usually programmed for a duration of three weeks (including install and get-out time), though can vary.
