Vice Chancellor's Scholarship

The Vice Chancellor's Scholarship is available to UK and EU undergraduates with AAB grades or above (136 UCAS tariff points), an International Baccalaureate score of 34, or equivalent and intending to study a full-time three-year bachelor's degree (BA/BSc/BEng).

Achievement Scholarship

The Achievement Scholarship is awarded to a select number of UK and EU undergraduate students who've earned ABB grades or above (128 UCAS tariff points), or equivalent. Students must be studying a full time three year bachelors degree (BA/BSc/BEng) unless there are exceptional circumstances preventing full time study.

STEM Scholarship

The STEM Scholarship is available to UK and EU students applying for an undergraduate or postgraduate degree in one of these areas: Animal Sciences, Architecture, Building and Construction, Computing and Digital Technology, Engineering, Psychology, Sciences, Nutritional and Pharmaceutical

Undergraduates to be considered for this award should have completed STEM GCSE subjects and have an interest in working in the field. Postgraduate students should have completed STEM GCSE subjects and a relevant undergraduate degree, and have an interest in working in the field.
